## About OMRI

The Organic Materials Review Institute (OMRI) is a **national nonprofit organization that determines which input products are allowed for use in organic production and processing. OMRI Listed—or approved—products may be used on operations that are certified organic under the USDA National Organic Program.**

OMRI's funding comes from a variety of sources, including sales of publications, grants, donations, and [subscriptions](#). Mainly, however, the organization generates income through fees collected for the review of products intended for use in organic production or processing. Also, OMRI operates an organic seed [information service](#) to help growers find organic seeds.

### Organizational Structure

A professional [staff](#) of 14 run the organization's various programs and administration out of the [Eugene, Oregon](#) office.

The OMRI staff is governed by a [Board of Directors](#), which is broadly representative of the organic industry. Board members represents certifiers, farmers, input suppliers, processors, handlers, consumer organizations, and animal welfare and environmental groups.

The OMRI [Advisory Council](#) is composed of independent, professional experts from industry, academia, and public interest groups in the organic community. The Advisory Council makes policies and standards recommendations to the Board of Directors.

There are three OMRI Review Panels: Crops, Livestock, and Processing and Handling. They make decisions on product applications for the OMRI Review Program.

### OMRI Review Program

OMRI's core service is the Review Program. **OMRI accepts applications for products intended to be used in organic production or processing to determine whether are in fact allowed under the National Organic Program.** Some typical examples of the types of OMRI reviews are fertilizers for organic farming and feed supplements for organic animal production.

After staff review, applications are submitted to the Review Panel. When the Review Panel votes to accept an application, the product becomes OMRI Listed. This means that the company is permitted to say 'OMRI Listed' on the product's label and any promotional literature. OMRI Listed products are suitable for use in organic production or food processing. Also, OMRI Listed are included on the [OMRI Products List](#).



Product reviews are conducted as a third-party review of products. This means that **OMRI is a disinterested party that makes recommendations to the organic operator and certifier.**

**Regulation governing intrants**

Suppliers of intrants are not subject to any specific mandatory controls within the context of the different regulations governing organic farming, with the exception of nutritional supplements for animals within the meaning of EC regulation no. 2092/91 amended. It is therefore advisable for the user to ensure the compliance of his purchases, by obtaining exhaustive details of the intrant's composition. **ECOCERT proposes that intrants manufacturers certify the conformity of their products**, for which ECOCERT has developed a standard
